SCI CAN FOUNDATION POLICY AND PROCEDURES STATEMENT

Mission: To promote long-term health and recovery of individuals with spinal cord injuries by supporting organizations that provide therapy, housing, and other resources that would not be otherwise available.

Application Process: Applications must be completed in full, signed, and post marked by the application deadline of December 31st of the current year. Applications will be reviewed after December 31st. Applicants will be notified of results of application within 4 weeks of the application deadline.

Selection Process: Selection will be determined by a 2/3 vote of approval by the SCI CAN Foundation Board of Directors. Criteria for selection will include number of individuals with spinal cord injuries served, number of individuals with spinal cord injuries served per cost of request, SCI CAN Foundation funds available, Applicant's plan for long-term support of the proposed project, and the extent and degree of availability and accessibility provided individuals with spinal cord injuries with the proposed project.

Grant conditions: We work diligently to raise funds in order to promote our mission. We work diligently in the application and selection process in order to insure that the grants which are awarded are those most likely to promote our mission. Additionally, we work very hard to make certain that once a grant is awarded, the funds are used consistent with the application and selection process. Pursuant to that objective, the Applicant is required to use the funds in a manner consistent with the application submitted. Failure to use the funds in such a manner subjects the Applicant to rescission of the grant by SCI CAN Foundation. The Applicant agrees to provide annual reports to SCI CAN Foundation setting forth an accounting of the use of all funds donated. The Applicant will also allow SCI CAN Foundation physical access to the Applicant's premises in order to verify usage of the grant funds consistent with the application. It is understood and agreed that in retaining the right to verify use of grant funds consistent with the application process, SCI CAN Foundation does not assume any liabilities or responsibilities with respect to any equipment or programs funded with the grant. The Applicant will be solely responsible for any maintenance, service, care, advancements in technology, insurance, training, supervision and all other matters associated with the proper implementation, oversight and continuation of the Applicant's proposal.
